## THE ALLIANCE AMBASSADORS LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

### PURPOSE

The Leadership Development Program will be a 2.5-day intensive introduction to the work of the Alliance and the principles, processes, and practice of leadership and cross-cultural understanding to help enhance oral health and peace across borders.

By the end of the workshop participants will be able to:

- More fully understand the role of the Alliance and some of the ways in which, as participants, they can contribute to improving oral health across borders;
- Understand and apply in practice some of the concepts, processes, and tools that will form the core of the blended learning leadership program to be rolled out in 2014;
- Appreciate their own personal leadership styles, the characteristics of effective team work, and the common dysfunctions that can limit team effectiveness;
- Understand how to proactively address situations when conflict arises and understand the conscious and unconscious biases that can arise – and how to be more self-aware of their impact; and
- Understand better the nature of ‘Alliance Leadership’ and the dimensions and dynamics of leadership in this context;
- Start the process of developing a plan to work more closely with others on an Alliance project; and
- Consider how they can play a part in the delivery of the blended learning program in 2014 and beyond.

The lectures of this training program will be recorded and will be available to members for use in their organizations.
